3. A letter of recommendation from a faculty member of your institution or from an editor of a news organization at which you have been employed or been an intern. This letter MUST be sent directly by the individual making the recommendation, not attached to this application form.
4. Six clips from a student or other publication (including Web publications) of stories you have written, or stories you have edited (with headlines you have written) or six photographs or graphics or layouts. (Photographs and graphics may be from an unpublished portfolio.)

The application AND the letter of recommendation must be postmarked no later than Oct. 24, 2009.
